

Individuals with Serious Mental Illness

...die more than 30 years younger than their peers

At least 75% smoke tobacco

40-60% of those with schizophrenia are overweight

15% have diabetes

Unemployed at rate of 78%

Six times more likely as the general population to die by suicide

12 million visits annually to ERs by people with mental health (MH)/substance use disorder (SUD)

70% with significant MH/SUD had at least one chronic health condition, 45% have two, and almost 30% have three or more

Have 50% decreased likelihood of survival without strong social relationships
